## Sherman County Libertarian Party Resolution 23-02 Concerning Oregon Senate Bill 1045

**Whereas**, the Oregon Department of Education has a history of forcing gender identity politics into Oregonian schools and classrooms<sup>1</sup>, and;

**Whereas**, the Oregon Department of Education forced Oregonian schools to require COVID vaccine/injections for staff and volunteers, to enforce mask mandates, and to force lockdowns, and;

**Whereas**, the Sherman County Libertarian Party supports the dissolution of the Oregon Department of Education<sup>1</sup>, and;

**Whereas**, the Oregon Secretary of State and Oregon Audits Division published the "K-12 Education – Systemic Risk Report"<sup>2</sup> in May of 2022, which concludes that "a lack of intervention by the ODE [Oregon Department of Education], despite significant problems at the school and district level, has been a larger problem than infringement on local control," and;

**Whereas**, Oregon Senate Bill 1045<sup>3</sup> is a bill intended to increase the power and influence of the State of Oregon over schools, further removing local control from elected school boards,

**IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the Sherman County Libertarian Party opposes Oregon Senate Bill 1045.
